As a profoundly British restaurant, Bentley's is delighted to be pouring some top cuvées from around our fair isle.

The Romans introduced winemaking to the UK, in a period with a relatively warm climate. During the 20th Century, England has made great efforts to grow its wine production. Due to our classically British climate, our soils are better suited to producing Sparkling wine, however we have made steps towards a higher production of still Red and White due to new techniques and warming temperatures.

The majority of our wine comes from the South of England - Hampshire, Sussex, Kent, Essex - but there are also burgeoning vineyards in Wales and Yorkshire.

WHITE WINE - GERMANY & AUSTRIA

Winemaking in Germany and Austria have the knowledge of the Roman Empire, Emperor Charlemagne and the Cistercian monks to thank for bringing the style and wine knowledge to the regions, most notably the Burgundian grape, Pinot Noir.

In modern times it has become known for its sweeter style of wines, but the cream of the crop remains the grape varieties Gruner Veltliner, Riesling, Spätburgunder (Pinot Noir).

WHITE WINE - IBERIAN PENINSULAR

Winemaking in the Iberian Peninsula can be traced back to 9th Century with the local Iberians, Phoenicians and Romans all adding their identity to the craft. The history and different climates leave a range of different native grapes and unique wine styles throughout the region.

The popularity of both Spanish and Portuguese wines has been helped by the conquistadors who travelled to the new world bringing their wine with them, while Portuguese wines have a special place in English hearts and minds greatly helped by the British conflicts with France throughout history.
